

**Annex to Resolution No. 1/2021 of the Council of the Faculty of Geodesy and Cartography of January 21, 2021 about detailed rules for students registration valid for the academic year 2021/2022 (extract for English-taught studies)**

1. The minimum number of credit points (ECTS) required to register for the next study year or semester are as follows [...]:
  - b) for full-time second-cycle studies in the fields of Geodesy and Cartography (including the specialization of Mobile Mapping and Navigation Systems):
    - student must collect after the first semester 22 ECTS to be registered for the second semester;
    - student must collect after the first year 44 points to be registered for the second year.
2. The number of credit points gained in a semester is the sum of the points assigned to each course passed in that semester. In the passing of a subject, all types of classes (lectures, audit exercises, project exercises, computer exercises, laboratory exercises) included in a semester are considered in final settlement. Student gains points for a given subject when he/she completes all types of classes in the subject.
3. The arrears of subjects included in the programme of the studies for each semester may not exceed one year of study.
4. A prerequisite for obtaining registration for the next stage of study (semester or year) is the payment of all fees to the University.
5. In individual justified cases, the Dean has the right to mitigate registration requirements.
6. Obtaining permission to postpone the deadline for thesis submission referred to in the WUT Regulation of Studies is possible only if student of the last semester has all courses in study programme passed including diploma seminar, audit, laboratory, project and computer exercises and if student received a positive opinion about the progress of the diploma of his/her supervision.
7. Regulations related to the organization of studies and to law and obligations of students are defined with the WUT Regulations of Studies. The relevant deadlines (e.g. registration periods) are announced in the timetable for the academic year.
8. Rules for students registration are applied with the WUT Regulations of Studies.
